Nurse Practitioner Faculty

The Ida V. Moffett School of Nursing at Samford University invites applicants interested in serving in a Christian university environment to apply for a tenure track position. This faculty position is a twelve month appointment and is responsible for teaching in the graduate program primarily in the family nurse practitioner track.

Candidates must have a master's degree in nursing with an earned doctorate in nursing or related discipline and be nationally certified as a nurse practitioner (FNP, PNP, etc.). Candidates must also be licensed or eligible for licensure in Alabama as an APRN. In addition, the applicant should have a strong record of experience as a nurse practitioner and in the faculty roles of teaching and scholarship. Rank and salary are dependent upon qualifications, nurse practitioner experiences, previous academic teaching experiences, and scholarship accomplishments. Preference will be given to applicants who have experience in master's education as well as in on-line teaching. A commitment to Christian values, academic excellence and the ability to work effectively with faculty, students and colleagues is expected. Applicants are expected to be active members in a Christian church.
