



## **Faculty Position Department of Pharmacy Practice- Rural Public Health Ambulatory Care**

The McWhorter School of Pharmacy (MSOP) at Samford University invites applications for a full-time, non-tenure track appointment at the level of assistant, associate, or full professor in the Department of Pharmacy Practice. All Samford University benefits applicable to fulltime employees apply to this position. This position has clinical practice responsibilities in rural family medicine physicians' clinics in Marion, Alabama, in collaboration with Sowing Seeds of Hope. The faculty member will provide student instruction as part of their ambulatory care practice with rural healthcare providers in Perry County and be responsible for coordinating experiential education and service initiatives throughout west-central Alabama on behalf of MSOP.

Candidates should have a doctor of pharmacy degree from an ACPE accredited college/school of pharmacy and be eligible for licensure in the state of Alabama. Completion of a PGY-1 residency is required, with preference given to individuals who have completed a residency with emphasis in public health, primary care, or ambulatory care. Previous experience in pharmacy practice centered on addressing health disparities is desired. Board certification in a pharmacy care specialty is preferred. The faculty member must obtain and maintain certification as a preceptor by the Alabama State Board of Pharmacy. Candidates should exhibit excellent verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills, dedication to student-centered education, and be willing to contribute to and support the university's Christian mission.
