**Faculty Position in Social and Administrative Sciences**

The McWhorter School of Pharmacy (MSoP) at Samford University invites applications for a full-time, 12-month, tenure-track appointment in the Department of Pharmaceutical, Social and Administrative Sciences at the rank of assistant or associate professor. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Rank and salary are commensurate with experience and qualifications.

Qualified applicants will have a Ph.D. in pharmacy administration or a related field OR a professional pharmacy degree with an M.B.A. or other management-focused master's degree and at least five years of supervisory or relevant project management experience. The candidate should have expertise/interest in one or more of the following areas: health outcomes, health care policy, pharmacoepidemiology, population health, communication, health economics, strategic and financial planning, or leadership and human resources management. Preference will be given to candidates with a degree in pharmacy. Prior academic experience is advantageous, but not required.

The successful candidate will become one of four pharmacy administration faculty who have teaching responsibilities including the development, coordination, and delivery of a newly revised six-course didactic pharmacy administration sequence as well as optional participation in elective courses of interest. Numerous opportunities exist for service and research collaboration within the school, university, and our outstanding local health care community. Candidates should exhibit excellent verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills, dedication to student-centered education, and a commitment to the university's Christian mission.
