Qualified applicants will have a Ph.D. in pharmaceuticals or a related field. Post-doctoral training and/or a professional degree in pharmacy are preferred. Prior academic experience is advantageous, but not required.

The successful candidate will become one of four pharmaceuticals/pharmacokinetics faculty who have teaching responsibilities that include the coordination and delivery of this content area in a newly revised Pharm.D. curriculum. Opportunities exist for fruitful collaboration within the school, university and surrounding Birmingham-based medical and research institutions. Candidates should exhibit excellent verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills, dedication to student-centered education, and a commitment to the Christian mission of the University.
